A “postage” option is now included in French eBay User Accounts, when logged in to “My eBay”, under “My sales”.

All that is needed to use the new “pay for postage on-line” service is a printer and the weight and dimensions of the parcel. Sellers on the eBay.fr site who use Chronopost will get a **7% reduction** and will be redirected to the Chronopost.fr on-line store, where they can pay for shipping by bank debit card, Paypal or monthly direct debit if they are professional traders (SoHo).

All that remains is for them to print the shipping label, stick it on the parcel and take it to any Post Office, a Chronopost agency or a Chrono Relais point at a tobacco retailer’s place.

Paying for postage on-line creates an automatic link between the article that has been sold and the parcel’s monitoring number. Both buyer and seller are informed when the parcel is sent and can monitor its progress directly at “My eBay”, in their customer services zone at Chronopost.fr or by email or text message.
