



## **Chronopost International develops its Pre-paid range and launches Chronopass Classic envelope 1 with letterbox delivery option**

**Paris, 1 March 2005-** Chronopost International is developing its range of "Pre-paid" services in Metropolitan France with the launch of Chronopass Classic envelope 1 with a letterbox delivery option in the event of the addressee being absent.

The Chronopass "Pre-paid" solutions enable simplified mailing. Everything is included: packaging, transportation, express delivery and track and trace.

From now on, with Chronopass Classic envelope 1, the sender has two options in the event of the addressee being absent:

- For more comfort and speed the sender can choose a letterbox delivery so that the addressee can pick up their mail when they return
- If the sender prefers the delivery to be signed for, they can opt for the pending mail service whereby the envelope will be made available at a collection point. The addressee will need to go to the collection point counter with their calling card and they will be able to recuperate their envelope once they have signed for it.

If the addressee is present they simply have to sign for their envelope. In all events, the sender can track the delivery on [www.chronopost.fr](http://www.chronopost.fr) (date and hour of when the envelope was delivered directly to the addressee or placed in the letterbox).

Chronopass Classic envelope 1 is sold individually or in packs of 10 and is available in Chronopost International agencies and shops and in Post Offices, as well as by mail order,

Chronopass Classic envelope 1 was produced as part of an eco-design operation. By choosing the letterbox option, the sender contributes to limiting superfluous mileage and thus reducing CO2 emissions.
